On the 13th of June 09, we were ready and packed once again, for undertaking the planned building renovations on the secluded island of Ambrym, Vanuatu. I had the pleasure to be accompanied by Nahum Gray and my two boys Mariano and Enrico. This time we carried a heavy load of tools skill-saws, drills, chisels, hammers etc. After a three-hour flight with Air Vanuatu, we had a two-day stopover in Port Vila, the capital of Vanuatu, to do last minute purchases of nails, screws, bolts and nuts.

We then boarded a small "Pilatus six-seater" for the final 45 minute journey to our destination Ulei, a village with a tiny grass airstrip, situated directly by a rocky beach and literally hewn in to the lush, green bush on Ambrym. Brother Mael Moses and several of the fellowship's young brothers welcomed us with their happy smiles and a hearty spirited handshake, a typical Vanuatu custom.

As our baggage was overweight with our building tools, our luggage needed to follow us in another plane. This meant a wait of six hours that we filled with resting and games. In Vanuatu, everything runs on island time! Eventually one of the few Utes on the island drove us and our heavy load on the 40 minute, dirt road trail to Endu, our destination – home for 200 souls, where there is no power, no roads and no street lights but rich and lush nature. It was nearly dark by the time we arrived.

We had just enough time pitching tents, checking through all the timbers, corrugated roofing iron, cement bags, paints and other materials we had shipped over days before our arrival. We finally enjoyed a meal of the staple diet of "Lap Lap" a savoury pudding-like, local food made with tapioca, banana, taro or yam, mixed with crushed coconut. We ate in the dark, surrounded by the villagers, under a giant native tree.

The daunting task of renovating the building in just 5 days began to sink-in the next morning. However with the support of the brothers, and also men from the greater village, we began to make immediate progress.

Brother Nahum's forte was all the timberwork. He replaced parts of the roof

I smiled and asked the young lady behind the counter to give me two more breakfast meals on a separate tray. I then walked around the corner to the table that the men had chosen as a resting spot. I put the tray on the table and laid my hand on the blue-eyed gentleman's cold hand. He looked up at me with tears in his eyes, and said, 'Thank you'.



#### ~ He is Worthy ~ Pt 1

I've mentioned to you before that every single Old Testament shadow points to Calvary and that to me is exciting because Calvary is the answer to everything that we've just prayed about. Calvary is the answer to your healing. Calvary is the answer to your deliverance. Calvary is the answer to the baptism of The Holy Spirit. Whatever you need, Calvary answered that 2000 years ago. For such an important event every shadow in the Old Testament pointed to it and every major type and shadow in the New Testament points back to it. So we want to see the last and final display in the gentiles with regard to Calvary, pointing back to Calvary.

Revelation 5:1 And I saw in the right hand of Him that sat on the throne a Book written within and in the backside, sealed with seven seals. That's the seven sealed Book of the Bible. Reveals how God redeems His Church. We didn't redeem ourselves. You're here today because God called you. You wouldn't be here otherwise. So we didn't redeem ourselves. This Book that was revealed shows us that God redeems us because no man, the Bible says, calls on God. No man searches after God. God goes searching for man. So it says here:

V2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice: [here is the question] Who is worthy? Let me answer it - No one answered it. No one is worthy. to open the Book and to loose the seals thereof. Now this was perhaps asked in the audience of every great man of God, every apostle, every prophet, every major man who ever did anything for the Kingdom of God and perhaps we could look at great merit. Everyone was asked this question and not one of them went forward to take the Book - not Daniel, Joseph, David, NONE of them went forward.

V3 And no man in heaven [I want you to notice – Listen, this went out through Heaven and throughout the earth] No man in Heaven nor in the earth nor under the earth was able to open the Book nor to look thereon.

V4 And I wept much because no man

was found worthy to open and to read the Book, neither to look thereon.

V5 And one of the elders said unto me, Weep not.

Now you've got to remember why John was weeping. He was weeping because this is the final act of God's redemption. This is the capstone of redemption. This is what finishes and completes redemption. As I've said to you before, our life is not a line from point A to point B. Our life is a circle and so we have a point in our mind of God and we're going back to that point, but this time in a glorified body or a Theophany, depending on whether we go first or we come back in the rapture.

..And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: Behold the Lion of the tribe of Judah; the root of David, hath prevailed. There was One who wrestled and overcame for us! Weep not: Behold the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the root of David, hath prevailed to open the Book and to loose the seven seals thereof.

V6 And I beheld and lo in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain. Notice - even in the opening of the seven seals - there's a reason there's a Lamb in this scene: So that we don't turn this Scripture into theology; but that we allow it to take us back to Calvary. That's why it's redemption. That's why it's a Lamb, because it's the Book of redemption. In the midst of the elders stood a Lamb as it had been slain having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. Now, go down and look at verse 12 where they were singing, they were shouting and they were excited.

V9 And they sang a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof:: for thou wast slain and hast redeemed us to God by Thy blood, out of every kindred and tongue and people and nation. Notice now, the Book is open and this people are rejoicing and they're saying, You've done it all!! You've redeemed us out of every kindred, every tongue and people. And it goes on to say in v10, And hast made us, unto our God, Kings and Priests and we shall reign on the earth.

This Book - Revelations chapter 5, is Continued on Page 8

pointing us to a Millenium! Listen, backslider, lukewarm individual, the coming of the Lord is already in motion. All we are waiting for is the going away of the church. That's all we're waiting for and that can happen in a moment, in a twinkling of an eye. It goes on to say in verse 10:-

# He that Covereth Thee

The word 'religion' can also be interpreted 'covering'. In EZEKIEL 28:14 it reads Thou (Lucifer) art the anointed cherub that covereth; It is suggested that this scripture refers to the two golden cherubims covering the Ark of the Covenant - one was Michael, and the other Lucifer, just as they were both represented in Heaven and in Eden. We certainly don't need to be smart to realize that Lucifer is the cherub that is covering man today with his lies and various forms of false religions.

Back in the Garden of Eden, Adam and Eve

were covered by the Holy Veil of God through faith in the <u>full</u> Word. But when unbelief entered in through the lie of the serpent, that Holy Veil left them and they became unprotected, vulnerable, and naked, both spiritually and physically. It was Lucifer's false religious teaching that caused Eve to depart from the truth, just as it is with the denominations of today.

Today these religious coverings of Lucifer's lies are externalized and in part manifested by the clothing that people wear, or in most cases don't wear. The Holy Veil of God, in 'God's Eden', has been replaced by a lust veil today in 'satan's eden', and as the covering of a Holy Veil prevented Adam and Eve from seeing each other's nakedness, so now satan's lust veil blinds the people from seeing that they are naked. As the scripture states of this age, they are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked, and know it not.

We can see then how this covering cherub 'Lucifer' is at the very heart of the fashion business through which the lust of the eyes is directly connected to the original sin of sensualism and sex, in direct opposition to the revelation of the spoken creative Word of God that will beautify and 'face lift' our natural bodies at the last trump.

## He that Covereth Thee

Concerning this last age Jesus counsels us in Revelation 3:18 to 'buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear.' This gold tried in the fire is the pure revelation of God as spoken through the seventh angel that manifests a Christ-like character produced in the fiery furnace of affliction. There is a price we have to pay for this gold, and it is the price of our time, dedication, and endurance.

It was at midnight in the harvest time (harvest time represents the end of the world) that Ruth the gentile required of Boaz to cover her with his garment. We also see Esther wearing the garments provided by Hegai the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, (which represents brother Branham in anti type) in order to be accepted by King Ahasuerus (a type of Christ).

Now if you would follow my thought closely: We know that the rapture process consists of the shout, voice and trump - the trump being the final climax, the literal body change part of the rapture process. We must be a part of the shout (which brother Branham states clearly is the Message), in order to be a part of the body change and rapture.

Michael (Christ) the mighty covering angel of Revelation 10:1 has descended through the voice of the seventh earthly angel (Revelation 10:7) to cloth our souls with truth. This message isn't some man made lie inspired by Lucifer. It is the Person of The Word which is Christ His very self, He is our covering cherubim. This covering of truth over the bride will climax with us being clothed with a glorified body.

Under 'the shout' phase of the message, the body already begins to turn heavenly. In other words the natural body begins to noticeably change its outward appearance by the way it adorns itself (dress code etc). It is the earnest (deposit or down payment) that a complete change is soon to follow. While the rest of the world is manifesting their end by the way they are acting and undressing, the members of the bride are showing that the process of the change has already begun by the way they are acting and dressing.

That is why professing message people

that don't act and dress right according to what brother Branham taught, still require The Word of the hour to dress their soul by faith and obedience. The outer covering reflects the inner covering as it did in Eden with Eve. When she was covered with doubt in her soul by the serpent's lie, her outer flesh became exposed.

Two covering Angels; one is Michael (Christ) and the other is Lucifer (satan). Both are contending for the souls of men, both were in heaven, both were in God's Eden. Now both are in satan's eden. When Lucifer covered Eve with his false religion it resulted in a physical body change from immortality to mortality. In this hour Christ is covering His bride in the robes of His own righteousness through the washing of the water by the pure Word. This will reverse the original curse and bring about the change back from mortality to immortality.

He that covereth thee must first cover your soul with the robe of the original faith as satan covered Eve's soul with the robe of the original doubt. Satan through the serpent became a voice to Eve. It was by a voice that Eve's soul was darkened and she received her body change from immortal life to physical death. Notice, her change took place from the inside out.


SO IT IS under the sound of the voice of the seventh and last Angel. God sent a vessel that he could speak through. The change is taking place from the inside out, and that change has already begun within us if we are true believers of the message.

Take courage, for He that covereth thee through the shout of the message will not rest (like Boaz with Ruth) until he has brought you to a full restoration, soul, spirit and body. He has begun an irreversible cycle in your being that cannot be stopped. Its process will go on until it changes you in the very atoms of your natural body and you will realize a complete covering has taken place. It is the glorified body! And that's the body we'll all need in order to go in the rapture. The great covering Angel has come. He is here now. It is Christ; it is 'He that covereth thee'.

May God through His Word reveal Himself to each one of us is my sincere prayer.

Revelation 1:4-6

4 JOHN to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven spirits which are before his throne;

5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince (ruler) of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood.

6 And hath made us "kings and priests" unto god and his father; to him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.

Notice hath (already) made us "kings and priests" (predestinated).

Mathew 3:1

 IN those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,

2 And saying, Repent ye: for "the kingdom of heaven" is at hand.

Mathew 4:17

17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for "the kingdom of heaven" is at hand.

The prophet and the word both preach the same message repent – for "the kingdom of heaven" is at hand – "the kingdom" from above has descended into the Earth and is totally separate and unique from all other kingdoms of the earth.

The Jews were looking for the restoration of "the kingdom." Nicodemus ruler of the Jews came to Jesus by night.

John 3:1-7 Jesus said Except a man be born again, he cannot see "the kingdom of God." Except a man be born of water and of the spirit he cannot enter into "the kingdom of God."

Luke 17:20-21 He was demanded of the Pharisees, when "the kingdom of God" should come. The "kingdom of god" cometh not with observation (not an outward manifestation) "the kingdom of God" is within you.

Even in the book of Acts 1:6 "Lord wilt thou at this time restore again "the kingdom" to Israel.

People are always looking for an outside manifestation of the kingdom, an outside manifestation of the church but it's hidden from the wise and the prudent.

Paul spoke of this mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations but now is made manifest to his saints.

To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the gentiles which is Christ in you the hope of glory.

Jesus declared concerning Peter's Revelation that "Thou art the Christ the Son of the living God" flesh and blood hath not revealed this unto thee but my father, which is in heaven.

A Revelation from the Kingdom of heaven, then Jesus gave Peter the keys to that kingdom. Divine Revelation opens up the kingdom to the believer.

The king comes within us with his kingdom from heaven and now the realization dawns that he hath made us kings and priests in his kingdom.

A king is "Anointed" to reign, a priest is "Anointed" to minister and we have a prophetic "Anointed" message. Therefore we have a three fold "Anointing" in this kingdom.

A King to reign in right-wiseness (righteousness); a priest to offer up spiritual sacrifices and to show forth the praises (virtues) of him who hath called us out of darkness into his marvellous light.

This is "The kingdom Of Light."

12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into "the Kingdom" (reign) of his dear Son.

The Original spoken word was "Let there be light." This message is that same light and this gospel of the "Kingdom" shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations and then shall the end come.

### Forgiveness, reconciliation and repentance

Many are quick to point out to us that forgiveness is an important part of Jesus' teachings. While this is true it is not an excuse for glossing over problems and unresolved issues that have occurred in the past. The truth is that there can be no real forgiveness with God or men until first repentance has occurred and reconciliation has been made. Brother Branham often said that the Devil cannot repent. If he could then he would be your brother. In other words God cannot forgive the Devil because he (Satan) has no capacity for repentance. Now don't be fooled. The Devil and his angels all fear God and tremble before Him, they all feign worship of Him yet not to the full acknowledging of the truth, not with real fruits of repentance. A devil may be quick to beg for forgiveness and plead for mercy but this is not true repentance. They may appear to be willing to do works to atone for their sins but this is not scriptural. Penance is a Catholic dogma. Jesus taught us that if you are going to the altar to make your offering (in other words to pray) and remember that a fellow Christian has something justifiable against you, to leave your gift at the altar and go to that person and be reconciled first. Yet it seems in this world today that people are not willing to face responsibility for their actions wishing rather to exercise a belief in some kind of divine benevolence that can overlook all of these things. We should look to the prophet's own ministry to see the truth of how God deals in these matters. Many times through the gift that God gave him brother Branham was able to pinpoint those unresolved issues - he called them 'unconfessed sin' - and he would instruct the person or persons to go and make the thing right first and then God would hear their request and meet their need.
