
On the wings of a prayer

God raised up more interpreters/translators in Burma (Sister Neti, Brother Soso, Brother Alfred Biaka & Brother Zalai Saw) that will definitely help spread the Message faster.

The recently concluded Mission Trip to Myanmar by brother Nestor Espanola and Brother Danny Del Mundo was a real success for God s glory.

New Developments:

- 1. At least three more translators have been added to the original set of translators. This will surely increase the number of translated books from a single book per month to expectedly an average of three books or more in a month.
- 2. The ministers are now working together for a common cause of reaching that last predestinated seed rather than aiming to build foundations to cater for the less fortunate citizens of Myanmar. This is an indication that the ministers are now more focused in searching for the deeper Truth.
- 3. The translators have received brand new tools for translation works such as: Laptops, Personal Computers and Recorders. It has been found out that the translators are still using cassette tape players. No wonder, they could only produce one book a month. Today, by the use of new equipment, they can work more efficiently and effectively.
- 4. Live sermon interpreters have now come into open and get involved in the ministry making way for the visiting missionaries to minister separately and be able to visit more churches.

Part 2 Now, if Psalms 27 is going to be a Background for the Rapture, I would like for us to look at it today, look at the verses of it, keep in mind that the verses of it has part of the mystery of the condition of the circumstance that will exist before the Rapture will take place.

Now isn't it amazing that Brother Branham does not read the setting of the Red Sea. Isn't it amazing he does not read the miracles of the breaking of the loaves, or the fishes and the bread, or he doesn't read Jesus walking on the water? Why doesn't He read some of the great miracles or the supernatural?

Why would he read Psalms ch 27 unless it has a very great fitting for the condition that will exist for the Rapture? Now, we long, we desire, we so hunger for that Body change, do we not? I do believe, no doubt that there are people sitting right here who will not die. There are people sitting right here in this building today who will be changed. Do you believe that? – that our bodies actually will be changed?

And what I've got at the moment is that we are planning a youth rally – the world's greatest youth rally. As a matter of fact, there won't be any old folks there. No old folks will be invited. It's only for the youth and everyone there will be a young person. Praise the Lord. And we will be changed in a moment, in a twinkling of an eye. Oh praise the Lord.

Now, let's look at this verse again and we'll go real slow with this, if you don't mind. A Psalm of David – '*The Lord is my Light*' and remember this is a background for a condition which will exist for something that will be experienced – \Box *the Lord is my Light* and the Hebrew word is already *which is light of human illuminaries* \Box which is the moon, the sun, the stars or where the line of the lamp of life is.

Now I want you to notice now that David starts out with this and he says, '*The Lord is my Light and my Salvation* but what is the wonderful thing to me is that David was also crucified in his day for being the Light of his people, so we are seeing significance that David is showing in this parable of the setting of the rapture that the Lord is his Light and by doing that, David also becomes a light to his people.

So there is a unity that is going on between the writer and the Inspirer, which is Almighty God Himself. And in this a oneness which is being created by the Almighty that David has become what he has been saying about God. Now he says that 'God is my light but we find also in 2nd Samuel 21-17, 'But Abishai the son of Zeruiah succoured him, and smote the Philistine, and killed him. Then the men of David sware unto him, saying, \Box Thou shalt go no more out with us to battle, that thou quench not the light of Israel \Box So now David becomes what the Lord is to him.

So David is the light. So you realise friend that this is where the people in the message have stopped because the Light of God at one time was Brother Branham, when Bro. Branham was here.

Jesus says about John the Baptist that John was a great and shining light. Notice how He said that, John was a great and shining Light and you rejoiced in his light for a season. But when Jesus said this. John is no longer the Light, Jesus was... As time goes on that light goes on to a further embodiment to where it was no longer Jesus in a body of flesh,

Who were the Apostles? Did you ever notice how demonic power was against Jesus? It was never against the Disciples. They were not the manifested Light. They were simply the followers around Jesus, but they had not become the personification of Light yet but once Jesus is taken away you notice how the battle changes then?

Automatically it goes to the Word. The Apostles, now they become the Light of the day.

When Brother Branham was here, truly Brother Branham was the Light of the day but events may prove our prophecy. He said, the Believers see The Word made flesh and that is the Light of the day. When Brother Branham was here, he was the Word made flesh.

So guess what? Where The Word is made flesh? **Behold! Behold! Here is The Word made flesh. Here is the Light of the day!** That's why you are fighting such battles, that's why you are going through such things, because you are the only threat that satan has left on this earth. Oh – Praise the Lord! Can you imagine today, that as the real people of God? We become the very Light of The Word \square The Word made manifest.

Now notice, he said, '*The Lord is my Light and* $my Salvation \square$ Now, why would he say that God is, and not the church and not about Israel and what about the Torah? And what about the Mishnah? And what about all the great work? But

He does not focus on it just being the law or what is written down, but He makes Salvation a **person...** The Lord is my Light and my Salvation: whom shall I fear?'

Oh now, wait a minute. I thought I was talking about before the rapture? What have we got to fear? What is in the world to fear? Eh, looking in the natural sense friends, there's all kinds of things all around us, so why would he say 'Of whom shall I fear? Look at this Word – be afraid, be fearful, to be dreadful or to terrify? 'Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life

Now, if this is a condition that will exist, was in where something will be experienced, I wonder if this is why there is so many things around us of cancer and diseases and trouble around your home, trouble in your job, trouble in our nation, trouble in our nation has never been where it's at now: politically, economically, everywhere we look, there are all sorts of troubles.

Is not that, the condition described before the rapture, but we don't want to get our eyes just on the troubles and get focused there. We don't want to get our eyes just on the money and politics and get focused there. But we want to remember – *The Lord is the Strength of My Life*.

I can't just live this Word because I memorise and memorise and I quote. How would I be when I get old and my memory is not so good? I'm so glad the Holy Ghost is still true when you cannot remember the Word like you did when you were younger: when you don't have the strength to do as you did: *but the Lord is the strength of my life* It's not by memory, it's not by persistence, but The Lord is the way that I will take the Rapture. I know we are clearly quoted on this, it's so commonplace, but **If the Lord is on our side, who can be against us?!**

The Identity Of The Bride Of Jesus Christ Pt 2

Apostle Paul speaks about a presentation – A marriage officer. We see that none of the animals was made in the image of God.

Adam was created male and female in the image of God. Then God **formed** man from the dust of the earth and breathed ino him the breath of life and man became a living soul.

And the LORD <u>God formed man</u> of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. *Genesis 2:7*

The first original human was created then formed by God was a beautiful young man, a non-perishable soul. He was neither a baby nor an old man but a young man and God being his Parent.

We see how the Creator made everything male and female after its own kind. Adam the first original human holds the key of all humans. He was a miniature world. The world of humans was in the first human.

Adam had dominion and authority over the earth as a son of God, yet he was lonely. God reveals His thoughts

18 And the LORD God said, it is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a help meet for him. Genesis 2:18

God does not go to outside material to make His first son, Adam a bride. He takes from the existing material. He puts him under anaesthetic, a deep sleep and He takes from Adam to build for him a bride.

And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; Genesis 2:21

The Identity of the Bride of Jesus Christ

Everything that Eve had come from Adam, the first bridegroom. She was an extension of him.

So we see God was the first surgeon performing the operation to provide his son Adam, a bride. Taking from Adam's body and building him a bride.

This reveals to us that she was tied to him and showing us that the Bride was part of the bridegroom and that her identification was in the Bridegroom Adam.

She was Him in Bride form. After removing a part of Adam's bone then closing up the flesh, He then takes the role of a marriage officer, introducing the woman, to Adam to see what he would call her. Introducing Adam back to Adam in Bride form. The form was different but she was still Adam.

And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. Genesis 2:23

He gives the reason why he is calling her woman because she was taken out of man.

So we see how God was reflecting himself. The first Adam was given a bride. She came from him and was introduced back to him in bride form. God took a rib from Adam and built a Bride and presented her faultless to Adam.

The Identity of the Bride of Jesus Christ

She, the Bride consists of individuals around the world and not a certain organisation, but a people from all walks of life, and called by the Voice of the Son of Man, Jesus Christ.

- 7. By denying her, Adam would have denied himself.
- 7. She will be in Bride Form.
- She was Adam in bride form.
 As He is The Word, so The Bride of Jesus Christ around The world will be abiding in His Word.

God bless you brethren. As I write this report, I am in accommodation in Noumea in our final 2 days



before returning to New Zealand. Over the past few years Bro' Alex Hoarau has been labouring in the mission fields around the Indian Ocean and in French speaking nations - New Caledonia being one of the francophone nations in the South Pacific he has been concentrating on of late.

It is not an easy nation to operate in as it is heavily catholicised with a mixture of traditional culture amongst the native Kanake. The spirit of this nation has cast fear over the people that make it difficult for them to break through into the reality of the move of God for this day.

Bro' Alex and I went to Lifou Island off the New Caledonian coast for 4 days to further advance this message and the walls and barriers have finally started crumbling. Lifou is the largest coral atoll in

the world with an area of 400 square miles and a population of 10,000 native inhabitants. In the 1800's this island was the first place the early missionaries landed to bring the gospel to New Caledonia. It is the first place in New Caledonia to receive the message of the hour.



After returning to Noumea (the capital) some new contacts were made amongst the non-denominational groups and an open door has been made to freely preach the message there when Bro' Alex returns sometime in the future. He is starting another work on Wallis Island – a French speaking atoll – north of Fiji on the 17^{th} of October, and then heading to the convention in Northland, New Zealand on the 22^{nd} .

Middle East: One More Soul...

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

It is a pleasure to write and share a few things with you that are currently taking place. As we look around, signs of the harvest are everywhere. Vines are laden with grapes. Figs and olives in their various hews of purple are ripening in the autumn sun. Bright red pomegranates boast their brilliant contrast. It's little wonder that God instituted a feast of thanksgiving during this time of harvest. Surely this is the season of "ingathering", not only natural - but spiritual as well as we look to the *Lord of the Harvest* to bring in souls.

2Jesus give me one more soul 2 are the words of a song I recently heard that have been seared into my heart and going over and over in my mind. This is the sole purpose we are here in the Middle East - and why we are so thankful for your many prayers and support. As difficult as it is to be laboring here alone, we console ourselves with the burden that perhaps just one more soul here in the most volatile region of the world, will be added to the Kingdom of God.



Syria: Through our contacts and via reports coming out of Syria, the situation there is a catastrophe beyond imagination - and getting worse by the day. At a time when medical care is needed more than ever, the war has torn Syria's respected health care system to shreds. A recent UN report indicated that "32 of the country 88 public hospitals have closed "" [1] The same report stated large numbers of doctors have left the country. Those that are in hospital are dying "because of hunger and severe malnutrition, and an absence of basic human necessities. $\mathbb{P}^{[n]}$ This crisis is exaggerated in part by gangs of armed terrorists who are preventing passage of basic necessities, including medicine and medical supplies.

After nearly a month without cell phone service, I managed to reach a brother in the northern city of Aleppo. It was agonizing to hear him say that; De are like prisoners in our city! We cand go anywhere because of the dangers...D Before we lost connection he also told me that for three months he has been unable to work. His bakery was closed due to his inability to purchase flour and supplies. The little thread of contact we have, along with knowing we are praying, encourages them greatly. He and his family are eagerly awaiting the day when we will meet again.

Another brother I am in contact with in Syria has not been able to return to his home in *Homs* since the conflict began - nearly two years ago. He and many other Christians from the area have taken shelter high in the mountains of Syria among families of a small Christian village.

As hopeless as this all seems to be, we are assured that the Lord of the Harvest is in control. That somehow through all this tragedy and suffering, He will get His Word to His elect – or His elect will escape and find their freedom in the Word. Your prayers for us as we earnestly seek His will, is greatly appreciated.



Armenia: Due to personal schedule conflicts, which included the funeral of Sister Rebekah's father, I was unable to join Brother Dima and Brother Mnats on their return ministry trip to Armenia September 6. In spite of my not going, it was your support that enabled the brothers to make this vital follow-up trip. By God's grace,

four people were baptized in true Christian faith.



This included follow up meetings in the northern village of Noyemberyan, where Brother Sasun (pictured with Brother Dima) and his wife live. As mentioned in the previous report, it was through Brother Sasun's contact with believers while working in Russia, that the Lord led him to hear of the truth of God's Word. Now back home, he was eager to have family and friends hear the truth. Brother Sasun opened his home for a small fellowship. Brother Dima and Brother Mnats preached the Gospel with power and authority – which had never been heard by many.

We trust and pray that this work will continue to grow and that others hungry for truth will be gathered together to the Word of God.

The brothers also had a fruitful time with Brother Artak and the believers in Sevan, teaching and helping them to understand the deeper truths. They were like "Philips" helping the Ethiopian^[iii] to understand the things he read. Joint services, promoting the bonds of fellowship and unity in the Word were again held with Brother Mitya, Pastor in the village of Arzni. He, along with many of his congregation, graciously reciprocated by coming to the meetings that were held at Brother Artak's. What a blessing to see the work of the ministry fulfilled and believers in Armenia being edified and coming into the unity of the faith. ^[iv]

Israel: An important prophecy that has been lying dormant for 65 years since Israel became a nation, concerns the rebuilding of the Temple. Though a nation, Israel is really void of its "soul" without the Temple and the ability to worship God as commanded. The bible is clear that the Temple will be rebuilt and commensurate with that, the restoration of all ordinances and sacrifices. Herein lays the mystery of how the Lord Jesus will even make Himself known^[v] to the descendants of Abraham. Brother Branham too spoke of this and how they will have **Etheir own temple worship again E**^[vi]. He even connected the ministry of the two witnesses of Revelation 11 with restored Temple worship; **ED** In Revelation 11**E** Moses and Elijah is to call Israel out of the old atonement of the lamb, and sheep, and blood, and goats, and sacrifice, to the real living Sacrifice, to the Word.**E**^[vii]

Interesting events in Israel of late are indicators that a growing movement within Israel is realizing the mistakes of their fore-fathers - and is prepared to do something about it.^[viii] A leading politician and member of the Knesset in Israel, has been demanding Israeli sovereignty on the Temple Mount. It appears that he represents a growing consensus within Israel that autonomy and control of the Jews holiest site be restored. He was even so bold as to propose that by next April; "A Pesach sacrifice (the Jewish Passover Feast held in April) being sacrificed on the Temple Mount." ^[ix]

If ever a time seemed "ripe" for Israel sovereignty to be realized, it could possibly be while Israel's enemies are in disarray with their own internal conflicts. Though this might appear to be a long way off, let us not forget that with God *all things are possible.* How quickly prophecy was fulfilled in Jesus' own ministry during his final days and weeks on earth. How inspiring it is to be living in these last days of our Lord's Redemption.

Once again we sincerely thank you for your love, your prayers and your support for us while we are here in the Middle East following the leadership of the Holy Spirit. We pray that the Lord will richly bless you,
