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

I remember going to church and seeing the long dresses and the long hair on the sisters, and how it spoke to my heart even at 11. I remember my feelings were like, "If there is a heaven this is probably what it's going to be filled with, people with long dresses and long hair, brothers that look so clean.

go back to California, so I wrote my Mom a letter telling her I wanted to stay with Dad.

Her answer was abrupt, and the police came to the door threatening to arrest Dad if he didn't send us back to California. Reluctantly we went back home and Mom, out of love, felt we were brainwashed. Several months passed and I expected that I could live a Christian life, but my friends pulled me down. I had no Mom or Dad to encourage me. What a blessing it is to have Christian parents serving God in this message, to encourage their children on.

Two years later I went back to visit Dad in Tucson, I didn't want to, but I loved Dad and wanted to see him. Again I was touched by the Lord and found myself at an altar asking for forgiveness and strength to live a Christian life. For 2 months I was in the Word. When I went back to California, I thought I was so full of God, everyone would see the change and be converted. I tried to witness, but no one wanted to listen. I was beginning to become an oddball with my short hair. I had so many questions, I wrote

my Dad' a letter asking him 22 typical elementary questions any young person might ask. I should have been bold in my faith making my stand as a Christian, but strong peer pressures weakened me, and I became a "silent Christian."

I told my Mom that I wouldn't watch T.V. because it was ungodly and unholy. T.V. was my #1 enemy. One night when no one was home. I went downstairs as it was time for my favourite T.V. show, which I hadn't seen for 3 months. So I turned it on and watched it, that was my first step towards compromise. Time passed and as it did, I began to släck in my Christian walk. I was 14, backslidden, and I hadn't cut my hair for 3 1/2 years. My Dad called me and asked me to go to Hawaii with him. So I saved my money and went with my sister and Dad. For the first week and half we partied and had fun, then Dad asked us to go to one meeting with him, where they were going to show the film, "Deep Calleth to the Deep.' I went and was quite bored until I heard Bro. Branham calling out the people, I had never

before heard of that gift. Again I was convicted and crying, but I tried to hide it. I knew it was the truth, but I wasn't ready to live it. I went home and it didn't have an instant effect on me at that time, but the Word is a seed, and in Isaiah 55:11 it says, "The Word shall not return unto you void." That meant so much to me after I was saved. I left the Word many times, but He never left me, He was always there keeping me. Amidst all the sin and corruption God kept me pure. When I was 17 Dad called again and asked me to visit him in the summer. He gave me 6 months notice, but I said "No Dad". I didn't want to go to church and be convicted again.

When Dad called again to ask if I would visit him in Tucson, and help him in his landscaping business, I had been working part time doing landscaping and I really enjoyed it. So I said I would think about it. When Dad called the third time. I was ready to get out of the house. The situation was getting worse at home between me and my step brother. Now at 17 years old I was again reunited with the people in Tucson. My brother Paul and I made an agreement that when either of us begin to show signs of getting touched by the Word, we would pack up and move back to California. The first service, I found myself crying and repenting at the altar. After church my brother told me to pack my things as it was time to go home. I told him to wait a few days. It wasn't but a few days later that Paul found himself under conviction. Soon we were both baptised.

When I was 18 years old, I began taking over the young peoples' meetings in Tucson. At 19, I began travelling with my Dad to many places in the world. I felt a calling to the ministry, but I wasn't sure. I knew I had to be sure in order to please the Lord. I prayed for a vindication and the Lord gave me two. One of them took place in a camp meeting in Colorado. A preacher, who didn't know me called my name, during a service, and told me I was ordained to preach the Gospel. I was born in the large gold-mining city of South Africa, Joannesburg, on the 25th of August 1961, I have lived here all my life. My father's parents were from the Portuguese Island of Maderia, and my mother's father from Britain and her mother an Afrikaaner (of Dutch decent) from South Africa - quite a mixture.

There was a Christian guy in the same camp as me during the last part of my army service, and we had a little argument or discussion one night - I would tell him about confession, Mary, the rosary, etc., and he

heaven by living a life of chastity, waking up in the early hours of the morning and saying the rosary, etc. and I've only just discovered it's a free gift from God." I climbed into the VW Combi and he and

I climbed into the VW Combi and he and this friend of my mother's from junior school who was with him at the time (both working for Campus Crusades for Christ) witnessed to me on the back seat of the Combi in the middle of town and I invited the Lord Jesus into my life right then and there.

For the rest of that year I fellowshipped at an Assembly's of God church going to Bible studies on Wednesdays, as well as attending other pentecostal churches and charismatic groups in Johannesburg. I had seen how possible by studying the Bible, that, Noah and the Ark, Adam & Eve, etc. could have been true, whereas before I was taught evolution at school and yet as a catholic we were taught about Abraham, Moses, Jesus, etc. If the beginning of the Bible was not true - then from where must I start believing it? Which is true? (I would ask myself).


I knew there was definitely something in Christianity because God had spoken to me in simple ways and had started working in my life. But I still had plenty of doubts and questions which kept me from putting my full trust in the Bible. My mother for one went to a pentecostal church for the first time where they took her into the back room, and after getting her to mumble a few sounds and words told her she now had the Holy Spirit. I just wanted answers to these kinds of questions where one church says this and another says that - who's right?

Another thing that kept me away from the Word was UFO's. I knew they were there and that people had seen them, but I wanted to know what they were.

By the end of the year I had saved enough money to travel abroad. The Lord had spoken that scripture about not to be lukewarm otherwise hw would spew me out of His mouth, but rather to be hot or cold. So I said to the Lord, "Lord, I can't be hot because Ihave so many doubts and questions to be answered, and I don't want to be lukewarm, so I'm going to go cold." - I kept it scriptural.

To cut it short I set out in January 1983 to travel Europe, States, Canada and others for a year. Most of the people I met I would talk to about God and what they believed, wanting to find out more about different religions and what other people of other cultures in other countries thought. I also tried out different drugs to see what kind of an effect it had on people - knowing I wouldn't get hooked.

After hitch-hiking, catching buses, etc. through the U.S.A. for six months and Greece for three weeks, I eventually picked up a newspaper in Los Angeles, California and read about the World Council of Churches which had just started in



I guess I'll start with the fact that I was brought up a strict Roman Catholic right from the time I was sprinkled as a baby. Our whole family would go to mass every Sunday, very rarely missing. When I was 16 years old my father passed away in a car accident while on route to Cape Town, on the coast. This came as a real shock to myself, my three younger brothers and sister and mother.

After I had lost my father I began to think more deeply of where we come from and what happens to us when we die. My mother then married my father's best friend (Jewish) which worked out so well because he was like a father to our family anyway. I finished high school and went straight into the army to do my two years national

would just say "But the Bible says such and such." These things he had said plus the life he led really spoke to me and stayed with me. For the first time I realized the difference between a Christian and a Catholic I always thought I was a Christian because I believed in Jesus Christ.

Anyway, I finished my army service and started managing a steak-house to save up money to go overseas - I had always had a desire to travel the world. It was during this year (1982) in March that I bumped into a brother who used to teach me (I say brother because I was at a Marist Brothers Catholic school and we were taught by brothers - similar to priests). I hadn't seen him for over two years and after saying 'hello'' etc. he said to me, ''Did you know I'm not a brother anymore?'' He said, ''for twenty three years I thought I could work my way to

Vancouver, Canada, July, August 1983. They only get together every eight years and so I thought it would be interesting because there were over 300 different denominations with delegates from all around the world. I took the bus up to Vancouver hoping to find out and learn more of what's happening in different countries around the world. I believed there wasn't much time left for this world anyway because of what the Bible says it would be like in the last days.

You know there are so many different theories of how we got here and what happen when we die - and I wanted to find one says from another planet, the Bible says Adam & Eve, but I didn't care if there were a million different theories and they all sounded good, there is still only one way we got here and one thing that's going to happen when we die - and I wanted tofind that truth. I truly believed that if a person searched with their whole heart, that the Creator up there would show them the truth and the way He wants us to be. There are so many different religions, which one was right?

Just because I was born a Roman Catholic must I remain a Catholic? What if I was born a Buddist - would I remain a buddist? Not for me. There was a truth out there, and I was going to search my whole life until I

found that truth!

I attended the World Council of Churches' meetings and you know in all the meetings I attended they hardly ever mentioned God or Jesus Christ, and these were supposed to be Christian churches that people belonged to and worshipped at. It was all politics and more politics money for arms against this or that country, how to sort out the nuclear arms race, etc. "Peace" being the main theme.

I had been collecting all the pamphlets and papers that were being handed out and would go back home in the evenings and read them. Three days before the end of the W.C.C. one of the pamphlets I collected was "William Branham predicts World Council of Churches events.

I said to one of the guys handing out, "Who is this William Branham?" He said, "He's the prophet to this generation. Well, I tell you that struck something deep down. I couldn't understand that in all the pentecostal churches I had attended I'd never heard the name William Branham, and some of the greatest meetings during his ministry were held in South Africa.

Although it made sense, I never knew there was meant to be a prophet in these last days, nor did I hear of anyone claiming to be a prophet because I would have at least looked into it and then made up my own mind. I was still very weary though, because I had come across so many different cults and movements in the States.

My next main stop was going to be in Evanston, Illinois to see a man by the name of Alan Hyneck about U.F.O's. He worked in the United States Air Force on Project Blue Book which is investigating U.F.O's for 10 years.

Project Blue Book has since been closed because of insufficient evidence, but he's still carrying on his own investigations.

The prophet said it was investigating angles of judgment, and God has given me peace in my heart about that - Glory!!

But I just could not leave Vancouver until I found out more about this so called prophet. I phoned Milko who was with Bro. Ashley when he handed me the pamphlet, and he picked me up and took me to Coverdale Bible Way. I saw the videos of Bro. Branham - "Deep Calleth the Deep" "Twentieth Century Prophet" ended up moving in with Milko and plugging into message tapes for about 2 weeks. Another thing that spoke to my heart was the fruits of these believers - the Bible says: "by their fruits you shall know them". Amen

I couldn't understand everything, but one thing that the Lord made very clear to me in black and white was the baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and the day I decided to get baptised, I went to Bro. The song titles are: Side One - His Eye is on the Sparrow, My Tribute, The Old Rugged Cross, He Touched Me, I Shall Know Him.


Side Two: It Won't Be Long, Peace in the Valley, No One Ever Cared for Me Like Jesus, My Song, and I Surrender All.
